PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Dear Modernite.

Greetings!

The age-old idiom, 'Man Proposes, God Disposes', could not have come true in a more absolute way than it has in 2020. With the onset of COVID-19 pandemic in India by mid-March 2020 and the Hon'ble Prime Minister announcing a nationwide lockdown, emergency brakes were applied on socio-economic activities of all kinds across the country. What was expected to be a two to three weeks 'temporary phase' to contain the coronavirus stretched to weeks and then months and, unfortunately, is still ongoing unabated. Never has the country and the world faced a graver crisis than COVID-19, with millions of lives being lost and a larger number being affected by the lethal virus.

Given the situation that confronted us, we decided to immediately suspend the Centenary Play rehearsals, which were ongoing in March 2020, further, we put on hold all balance activities on the MSOSA calendar for the year, namely the Centenary Play, Centenary Senior Modernites dinner, Centenary Modernites Conclave & Excellence Awards, Centenary Open Badminton Tournament, Guru Pranam and the Centenary Mega Event.

However, as the situation refused to get better, MSOSA decided to make use of the virtual medium to connect with the Modernites to keep the MSOSA flag flying amid the pandemic. MSOSA's Natak Mandli (the name we use for our Theatre Group) comprising Ms. Daksha Jaidka, Ms. Pratima Mittal, Ms. Jahnvi Sharma, Mr. Dhruv Tulli and some others got together and decided to launch 'Lockdown Entertainment Evening' on a trial basis. I was more than happy to support their idea and I must say it was indeed a great decision that paid off handsomely. The team successfully went on to organize 10 lockdown evenings over a period of 4 months, each having a special theme like the Presidents' special, Golden Jubilee (1970 batch) special, the Armed Forces Special, which was organized on August 15, as a tribute to our armed forces and had a participation of more than 150 Modernites serving and retired armed forces personnel.

The Guru Pranam event was also organized as a virtual 'Lockdown Evening' this year on September 5 (Teachers Day). We had more than 140 retired teachers who logged in to be a part of the event which included speeches by retired teachers and entertainment program by Modernites from across the globe.

On the occasion, MSOSA published a special brochure to honour the teachers and arranged to deliver the same along with a small souvenir to each teachers residence. Again, Daksha Jaidka, Pratima Mittal, Jahnvi Sharma, Dhruv Tulli put in a great amount of hard work to organize the event.

Despite the difficult times, MSOSA boldly decided to organize the Modernites Conclave & Excellence Awards 2020 on the front lawns of the school on November 8, with Covid 19 safety measures strictly in place. It was heartening to note that out of 10 Awardees, 8 were there in person to receive the award. On the occasion, the Modernites Trust also presented 'Guru Dakshina Award' to four retired teachers, two posthumously and two in-person. The panel discussion on the topic, 'Post Pandemic World: Transform or Perish' was chaired by Hon'ble Mr. Justice Sanjay Kishan Kaul, also chairman of the selection committee for the Excellence Awards. The event was streamed live across the world for the first time and we received a great response from Modernites for the same. I would like to especially thank Dr. Arvind Lal, batch of 1965, for sponsoring the event again this year and Mr. Suresh Gupta, batch of 1970, for supporting the event too.

Further, a special MSOSA mobile app has been designed and is about to be launched very shortly. The new app, with its several special features, shall strengthen the connectivity between MSOSA and Modernites shall also facilitate smooth and quick communication between Modernites. I sincerely hope you all will download it after its launch and will enjoy using it.

I would like to take this opportunity to record a special word of thanks for Mr. Rishabh Gulati, Managing Partner, News X and a Modernite from 2003 batch for agreeing to make NewsX as MSOSA's media partner for the centenary year celebrations. He and his team shot special interviews with 18 eminent Modernites (half an hour each) and also telecasted abridged versions on October 20, 2020 on NewsX channel during a special show on Modern School Centenary. While MSOSA and NewsX had plans to shoot 50 episodes with 50 eminent Modernites, the pandemic made it impossible to shoot more episodes. I do feel sad that we could not cover many of our outstanding Modernite achievers through this initiative called 'Master Class'. All episodes are available on YouTube now. Further, NewsX also organized two panel discussions, one with Presidents of alumni of eminent schools on Covid 19 and the other was a Centenary Special. Both panel discussions were telecasted live on NewsX and I had the honour of participating in both as President of MSOSA.

As I complete my Presidential term of two years and two months (the term was extended by two months in 2019 for the centenary celebrations), I can look back and say with immense satisfaction that despite COVID 19 coming in the way for the last 8 months, the term has been a very gratifying and a successful one. The entire Team MSOSA worked relentlessly and made sure that all our events were grand successes over the last 26 months. Due to a very strict financial discipline instilled at the beginning of the term of the current EC, we could generate a .

credible surplus from the events organized and were in a position to contribute Rs. 21 lakhs to the Modern School Centenary Project, Rs. 5 Lakhs for fight against COVID 19, Rs. 16 lakhs to the Modernites Trust to support merit scholars studying in Modern School, besides supporting several other charitable initiative I have to acknowledge the great work put in by the Executive Committee and the office bearers to make this possible.

My deep gratitude is due to the Board of Trustees, Modern Schools, specially Mr. Ashok Pratap Singh, Senior Trustee and Ms. Ambika Pant, Secretary, BOT, for their very encouraging support for MSOSA's activities throughout the last 26 months of the term of this committee.

I also wish to thank Dr. Vijay Datta, Principal, Modern School, Barakhamba Road, for being very supportive of our activities and allowing MSOSA to use the school infrastructure for several events and for organizing MSOSA's EC meetings.

Finally, I would like to thank my entire MSOSA Executive Committee and the office bearers namely Mr. Sharat Prakash Vice President, Mr. Vikas Mishra, Secretary, Mr. Manu Narang, Treasurer and Ms. Pratima Mittal, Joint Secretary, for the support and cooperation they have provided to me during the last 26 months which made everything possible. Without proactive support and hard work put in by the EC and the office bearers, we could have not achieved so much.

As they say, 'A captain is as good as his team', truly I was blessed to have a great team to work with. I also take this opportunity to convey my best wishes to the new incoming Executive Committee, which will be elected on November 29, 2020 at the AGM in Modern School and assure my successor and his team my full cooperation and support.






Modern School

Lala Raghubir Singh Sept 5, 1895

Lala Raghubir Singh, the founder of Modern School, was born in Delhi on 5th September 1895. Raghubir conceived an ambition to start a school on large and liberal lines, to provide leaders for a yet to be born nation.

He founded the school to provide quality education, and to foster an all-round growth of a child. He aspired to formulate a public school that incorporate the western lines and at the same time uphold Indian traditions. He devised a movement for better education which would provide a framework for freedom and social change. Lala Raghubir Singh was the spirit and soul of the school.

On his 125th birth Anniversary, MSOSA remembers him for the gift he has given us all-Modern School.



















MODERNITES CENTENARY GOLF FOR CHARITY

Mr. Amitabh Kant (Class of 1973) CEO, NITI Ayog, graced the occasion and presented the prizes to all the winners.








MSOSA NATAK MANDLI LOCKDOWN EVENINGS


GURUPRANAM
